Online referral to the Evelina School Nursing Service

Evelina London school nursing service is commencing the use of an online referral form to replace the current word document that you have been using to complete referrals to the School Nursing Service.

The online form can be accessed via www.evelinalondon.nhs.uk/schoolnursingreferrals

Once you have completed the form please click the submit button. You will then have the option of down loading a pdf of the referral you submitted for your records. The referral will be received and triaged by our duty desk. We will no longer be accepting the word document from October 2021.

Can we suggest you consider directing parents, carers and young people to self-refer to school nursing via the confidential text service. They will receive a response Monday to Friday 9:00-17:00 throughout the year (other than bank holidays).


Chronic Health Awareness Sessions
