Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will take place on Tuesday 28th June and will be on the Pride of London boat. The boat will travel along the River Thames whilst students celebrate their achievements with friends and teachers. The boat will leave from Festival Pier at 6.30pm and it is imperative that students are not late. The company will not wait for any guests, students or teachers, if they miss the departure time. Students will be able to buy soft drinks and enjoy desserts during the evening. Please note there will not be any other food served during the cruise. Students will be able to enjoy music provided by a DJ and take pictures with the famous London skyline in the background. Students will be supervised by teachers and members of staff from The Norwood School at all times. The boat will dock back at Festival Pier at 11pm. Students and families are responsible for travel to and from the Pier and we recommend that students are collected at the end of the evening. The Prom will only consist of students from The Norwood School who are in Year 11 and students are not permitted to bring friends who do not attend Norwood onto the boat. Once again, payment is made on the ParentPay system with tickets costing £10 (£6 for FSM students). The dress code will be Prom themed and students will typically wear suits or dresses.
