Who handles our access requests?

Safeguarding and Visiting the Norwood School

What are the rules for granting and refusing access requests?

We will grant access requests that meet the following criteria:

- Requests from Ofsted registered 11-19 providers
- That are reasonable and do not impact on existing educational provision for our students

What can providers expect once a request has been accepted?

Once we have approved a provider, we will work with them to identify the best method for providing access to our students.

Where possible, we will make the school hall, classrooms and private meeting rooms available to host discussions between providers and students. We will also make presentation equipment, such as projectors and televisions, available to providers should they be required.

Arrangements will be discussed in advance between Ms Patel and a nominated member of the provider's team.

Can providers leave prospectuses for students to read?

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus and other relevant course literature with Ms Patel, Ms Boyle or Ms Cunningham (Sixth Form Administrator).

Approval and review

This policy statement was approved by the school's Senior Leadership Team and link Governor in December 2022 under powers delegated by the Governing Body. It will be shared at a full Governors meeting March 2026.

The next review will take place in November 2028.
