



The Norwood School's Year 10 Homework Timetable 2019- 2020

This timetable is a guide for when you will be set homework each week.

Please be aware that some of your teachers may set your homework on a different day according to the curriculum you are studying. However, you will be given homework every week and this will be set on Show My Homework.

You should be spending between 2 to 3 hours on your homework each night. Depending on the task you have been set, your teacher will advise you as to how much time you should use to complete the task.

Make sure you are always clear about what you need to achieve for your homework, how long you should spend on it and when you need to hand it into your teacher. If you don't understand your homework, ask your teacher for help...don't get stuck at home!

In addition to the homework your subject teachers set you, you should also spend at least 30 minutes reading a novel each evening. Remember you can borrow a book from the school's Library or your local library. In addition to this, you should also read some non-fiction (e.g. biographies, newspapers, specialist magazines) according to your interests.
